



Thank you for choosing the Central YMCA of Youngstown Summer Day Camp! On behalf of all the counselors and coordinators I'm so excited to welcome your child(ren) to our facility for what we're promising will be the best summer ever. To help you plan for camp and get a clear idea of what your child's experience will be, we've put together this brochure. The following information is critical to ensuring your child's camp experience is a positive one, so please take the time to read through the entire brochure and the registration packet carefully.

At the YMCA we are here to make your kids feel welcome. Our number one mission at camp is to cultivate an environment where they can make new friends, feel safe and that they belong, and have a sense of achievement. We'll place your child in a group of similar-aged children, provide developmentally appropriate activities, and introduce them to new experiences, including swim lessons, free swim, outdoor time, arts and crafts, education and reading to help address summer learning loss, sport skill development, and more! Throughout the week, your child will develop a presentation (skit or dance) alongside their group to perform on Fridays for Spirit Games. Spirit Games celebrate the camper of the week, counselor of the week, and the winner of the presentation. Kids might be a little nervous the first time they have to do a skit, but the sense of pride they get being cheered by the whole room is a feeling they won't forget. At Day Camp, we have created a culture of inclusivity where all campers are welcome. Campers are valued and celebrated for who they are.

Safety is our top priority, and we will make sure your child(ren) is protected while they are with us this summer. Our camp is accredited with the American Camping Association through rigorous bylaws and examinations, and we are one of a select few Y's across the country accredited with our Child Safety Partner – Praesidium. Our staff take part in 30 hours of onsite training. We have a 1:12 ratio of children to staff members, and always keep an eye on the most up-to-date CDC guidelines should anything happen with global health concerns.

We're beyond honored to get to know your child(ren) this summer as we help instill in them the values of respect, responsibility, honesty, and caring into them.

### **Financial Assistance Two Ways**

Support from the YMCA Annual Campaign allows us to provide financial assistance up to 50% off to those who qualify. Forms are available at YMCAyo.org or picked up at the

Central Y Service Desk. Deadline for applications is two weeks prior to start of the camper's first day of camp. The form needs to be completed at least two weeks prior to camp!

Think you could qualify for a bigger discount?
We have partnered with the Department
of Jobs and Family Services this summer to
provide assistance to those who would qualify

for up to 100% off with the TANF application. This form needs to be completed at least one month before your child's start date of camp! The form is available in our registration packet and on our website. Must apply by May 1st.

ALL PAPERWORK MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED PRIOR TO FIRST DAY OF CAMP. Registration fee must be paid at the time papers are turned in. No paperwork, no camp. No exceptions! Registration deadline is 9:00 p.m. the Friday before the week attending camp, otherwise a \$20 late fee per child will be applied to those registering after that time.

Through Day Camp, and other youth development programs, the YMCA is working to keep kids active, and address gaps in learning when school is not in session. Summer Day Camp offers swimming,

arts & humanities, education, reading and writing help, cooking, sports, and much more.

#### **FIELD TRIPS**

Each week we'll be exploring somewhere new to help your camper broaden their horizon! Field trip fees are already incorporated into the cost of camp and is averaged out to \$30 per trip. Trips take place every Thursday, with the exception of one week on a Wednesday for the Pirates vs Guardians baseball game. Field trips are planned to be all-day experiences this year so punctuality on field trip days is essential. We will depart by 9:30am on Thursday and return by 3:30pm unless otherwise contacted ahead of time.

#### **GETTING OUT**

We believe in the importance of play and physical activity as in important part of a healthy development for a child. To accomplish this we'll be spending a majority of camp outside at the Davis Family Y, Austintown Township Park, visiting the Youngstown Public Library for special events, and playing many games of gaga ball in outdoor lot.

YMCA Camps are led by caring and trained youth developers who are dedicated to bringing out what is special and unique about your camper.

## **CAMP DETAILS**

Join us for a summer that will have your campers traveling the world with a passport to fun and exploring new cultures, while learning about new foods and going on exciting field trips!

This camp is designed for ages 6-13 and is held from 9:00 – 4:00pm. We offer before and after care for a small fee for early drop offs and late pickups (7:00am – 9:00am and/or 4:00pm – 6:00pm) Central Y Day Camp capacity is 80 campers per week. Campers may bring their own lunches that do not require refrigeration or heating but a free lunch option will always be available through our partnership with Heartreach Neighborhood Ministries.

Camp is charged by the week and registration for the following week must be done by 9:00pm the Friday before the week begins. A \$20 late fee per child will be applied to those that register after that time.



**REGULAR CAMP HOURS:** 9:00 – 4:00pm

**EXTENDED HOURS:** 7:00 – 9:00am & 4:00 – 6:00pm (\$25/week)

**REGISTRATION FEE:** \$30 one-time only fee, non-refundable! Registration packet MUST be turned in with payment. No exceptions.

**CAMP FEE:** \$170/week for members or \$200/week for non-members. Camp fees include weekly care costs (staffing), supplies, food supplies, and field trips.

**NOTE:** Weekly fees hold the spot at camp for your child that week. There are no discounts or refunds for days not attended.
