# **Obstacle Course**

Don't forget, a demonstration of the obstacle course will take place at 12:00 pm at the tug field. The course will be set up for practice between 10am and 12pm Saturday, September 9. During practice and the competition, there will be two identical obstacle courses in use. Heat 1 will start immediately following the demonstration.

#### **Volunteers**

Please remind your volunteers to check in up to **one hour prior** to the start of the event with which they will be assisting. They must check in no later than ½ **hour prior** to the start in order to receive credit. Check-in for the 10K and Walk events will be in the Covelli Center parking lot. Check-in for the Obstacle Course and Tug-o-War will be at the tug field near the YMCA's tent. A large number of volunteers are needed to run the Wean Park events. Your team's volunteers will be an important component of making these events a success. Please make sure they follow through on their commitment to volunteer. Keep in mind that any team member who turned in a waiver is eligible to volunteer and earn points for your team. A list of the volunteer duties for the September 9th events is included with this Captains' Clips.

#### **Tent Locations**

Also enclosed you will find a map containing hospitality tent assignments. Tents will be set-up on Friday and will be ready to go when you arrive Saturday morning September 9. The tables and chairs that you ordered will also be at your tent for you to set up as need be. All vehicles must be off of the field by 8:30am on Saturday. Tents will be removed following the awards ceremony at approximately 5pm.

# **Company Mascots**

If your team/company has a mascot or knows of one that is from any company or organization, please feel free to bring them to the events on Saturday, September 9 at Wean Park from 11am to around 2pm. There are always families there with their children and friends. What a great way to have fun at the Cup!

# **Kids' Events**

Please let all of your teammates know to bring their children for the kids' events that will be taking place at the Community Cup this year. Directly behind the YMCA tent there will be a bounce around slide from Confetti House for them to play on. The Youngstown Fire and Police Department will also be there with their vehicle for the kids to check out.

We will once again have the children's Tug-o-War. The Tug Meister has agreed to let the kiddos tug again this year, just like Mom and Dad. Have the kids ready to tug after the completion of the Obstacle Course. We'll make an announcement to call them out to the rope. With all of these kids events, it will truly be a full family experience.

#### **Awards Ceremony**

Please encourage your team members to stay for the Awards Ceremony following the Tug-o-War. We expect results to be tabulated within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the final tug. While waiting for the final results, teams will be able to find out who won the Youngstown Meltdown event, as well as the top two participants that lost the most weight. In addition to the "Most Spirited Team Award", the Awards & Festivities judges will bestow the "Best Tent Award" during the Awards Ceremony. Then of course, we will crown each Division with their Cup championship for 2023.
