The Community Cup is a corporate athletic challenge in which area organizations compete in a series of exciting events! We like to think of the "Cup" as the Mahoning Valley's version of the Olympics.

- ✓ Nurture wellness and teamwork as cultures within your organization, creating an atmosphere of enthusiasm, collaboration, and pride
- ✓ Influence commerce by generating business to business, and business to consumer relationships
- ✓ Prove that when we all work together, we can strengthen the foundation of our community



COMMUNITY CUP NUMBERS

2024 marks the 33rd year of this exciting community event. Annual program participation exceeds 2,000 people.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any employee of participating businesses/organizations and their spouses/partners. Organizations and smaller businesses may combine to form a team(s) – (e.g., safety services, community organizations). Businesses/organizations can compete in all events, or selected events. It is not required to participate in all 14 events.

DATES OF THE CUP

- June 3–August 24: Youngstown Meltdown
- August 9 (Friday): Opening Ceremonies, Torch Lighting, Banner Competition and Pep Rally Competition
- August 10 (Saturday): Bocce Tournament and Kickball Tournament
- August 23 (Friday): Basketball “Hot Shot” Competition and Scavenger Hunt
- August 24 (Saturday): Golf Scramble and Bowling Competition
- August 25 (Sunday): Corn Hole Tournament
- COMMUNITY CUP WEEKEND: In a fun, festive picnic atmosphere with team tents, employees, families, and friends celebrate their participation in the Community Cup.
- September 7 (Saturday): 10K Relay, Time–Predicted Walk, Obstacle Course, Tug–O–War, and Awards Ceremony

COST

FULL TEAM: \$700

- Will participate in 5 to 14 events
- Full Teams earn points towards the “Cup” as well as awards in individual events
- Full Teams with an abundance of participants can field a second, third, etc. single event team in any individual event. Cost per ADDED TEAM: \$100
- Single Event Teams are eligible to earn awards in that event.

PARTIAL TEAM: \$75 Registration Fee and \$100 per event

- Will participate in four events or less
- Partial Teams are eligible to earn awards in individual events

CLINICS

Clinics take place throughout the summer to teach team members fundamentals of applicable Community Cup events.

Events were selected to encourage participation regardless of fitness level or athletic ability.
Teams may earn additional points by volunteering during specific events.

SCAVENGER HUNT

Team Size: 4

Each team has one hour to visit key area Youngstown locations to find items.

GOLF SCRAMBLE

Team Size: 4 (2 male, 2 female)

Teams compete in a nine-hole scramble. One women’s shot must be used on each hole.

BOWLING

Sat Aug 24 • 4:00 p.m. • Camelot Lanes, Boardman

Team Size: 4 (2 male, 2 female)

Teams bowl for total pin count.

CORN HOLE

Sun Aug 25 • 12pm • Henry Stambaugh Golf Course

Team Size: 2 (1 male, 1 female)

Teams compete in a double elimination tournament.

10K MEDLEY RELAY

Sat Sept 7 • 9:00 a.m. • Wean Park

Team Size: 5 (minimum of 2 female)

Three run 1 mile, two runners split 5K distance.

3 MILE TIME PREDICTION WALK

Sat Sept 7 • 10:30 a.m. • Wean Park

Team Size: 10

Teams compete to come closest to a predicted time.

OBSTACLE COURSE

Sat Sept 7 • 12:30 p.m. • Wean Park

Team Size: 6 (2 must be female, 1 must be executive level)

Teams compete in a six-stage obstacle course

TUG-O-WAR

Sat Sept 7 • 2:00 p.m. • Wean Park

Team Size: 8–10 (half male, half female)

One of the more popular events of the Cup! Teams pull their opponents 12 feet from center to win.
