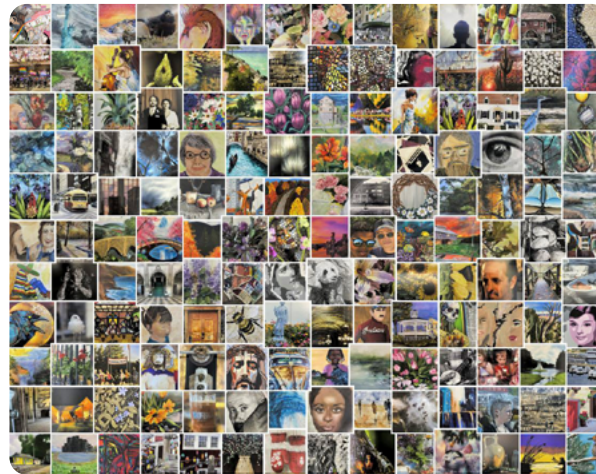

The Davis Family YMCA is hosting its annual juried art show in conjunction with National YMCA Arts Month.

But I Know What I Like is open to any adult, amateur or professional, within a 40-mile radius. The twist? It will be judge by non-experts, as in “I don’t know much about art, but I know what I like!”

All family-friendly art will be accepted.
Cash prizes will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to adults within 40-mile radius.
- Original works completed in the last 3 years.

SPECIFICATIONS

- All 2-dimensional pieces and small ceramics and sculptures will be accepted provided they are family-friendly.
- 2D pieces must be framed, wired, and ready to hang.
- Maximum size 40" in any direction, weight not to exceed 25 pounds.
- All pieces labeled on the back upper left-hand corner.

LIABILITY

While every precaution will be taken to care for the art, the YMCA is not responsible for any loss or damage.

SALES

Any sales made during the exhibition are subject to a 25% sales commission, with proceeds going to the John Patterson Art Scholarship Fund. Checks will be mailed within 30 days of the sale.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- One or two pieces may be entered for \$25. Third and subsequent pieces will be \$5 for each extra submission.
- The entry fee for one piece will be waived for anyone who has taken an Arts & Humanities Class at the Davis Family YMCA in 2024. A second piece may be entered for \$15. A third piece for \$5 more.
- Entries to be dropped off at the Davis Family YMCA, 45 McClurg Road, Boardman, on Friday September 26, 3-5 PM, or Saturday September 27, 10 AM-12 PM.
- Please have entry form and payment (cash or check) ready when dropping off artwork. Indicate sale price, POR (price on request), or NFS (not for sale).

RETURN OF ARTWORK

- Pieces must be removed from the Davis Family YMCA November 10-17 from 10 AM-5 PM.
- You must stop at the Service Desk to sign form before removing art from building.
- Pieces not removed by November 18 are subject to disposal.
