## OUR STAFF TEAM

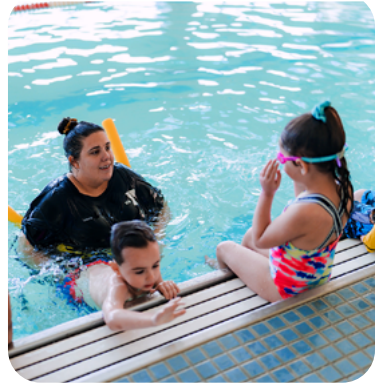

**AGES:** 3- and 4-year olds (all children must be fully potty-trained in order to attend)

**DAYS/TIMES:** Flexible scheduling Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

**FEES:** \$100 registration fee

## WEEKLY FEES:

- 3-year-olds PART TIME (10–32 hours/week) – \$220.00
- 3-year-olds FULL TIME (33 hours and above) – \$320.00
- 4-year-olds PART TIME (10–32 hours/week) -187.00
- 4-year-olds FULL TIME (33 hours and above) - \$285.00
